A BILL

1	SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION THAT LICENSED FIREARMS
2	DEALERS MAY TRANSFER FIREARMS TO
3	OTHER LICENSED FIREARMS DEALERS AT
4	PLACES OTHER THAN THE BUSINESS PREM-
5	ISES SPECIFIED ON THE LICENSE OF THE
6	TRANSFEROR DEALER.
7	(a) In General.—Section 923(j) of title 18, United
8	States Code, is amended by striking "conduct 'curios or
9	relics' firearms transfers' and inserting "conduct firearms
10	transfers".
11	(b) Rule of Construction.—Section 923 of such
12	title is amended by adding at the end the following:
13	"(m) This chapter shall not be interpreted to prohibit
14	a person licensed under this chapter from transferring a
15	firearm to another person so licensed, at a location other
16	than the premises from which the person is licensed to
17	conduct business under this chapter, or to require the pay-
18	ment of a separate fee under this section for doing so.".
