AN ACT

To amend the Agricultural Adjustment Act to remove the requirement that processors be members of an agency administering a marketing order applicable to pears.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PEAR MARKETING ORDERS.**

2 Section 8c(7)(C) of the Agricultural Adjustment Act
3 (7 U.S.C. 608c(7)(C)), reenacted with amendments by the
4 Agricultural Marketing Agreement Act of 1937, is amend-
5 ed in the last sentence—

6 (1) by striking “or pears”; and

7 (2) by striking “: *Provided,*” and all that fol-
8 lows through “be equal”.

2004.
