 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON SALE OF DISASTER LOANS.
 - 4 Section 4 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 633)
 - 5 is amended by adding at the end the following:
 - 6 "(g) Prohibition on Sale of Disaster Loans.—
 - 7 The Administrator may not sell any portion of the Admin-
 - 8 istration's interest in, or the rights of the Administration

- 1 with respect to, any loan made directly or through imme-
- 2 diate participation under section 7(b), including by direct
- 3 sale, through the sale of loan participations, or by includ-
- 4 ing such loans in a pool of assets for the purpose of selling

5 asset-backed securities.".
