3 **SECTION 1. S. TRUETT CATHY POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 255 North Main Street in
6 Jonesboro, Georgia, shall be known and designated as the
7 S. Truett Cathy Post Office Building.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the S. Truett Cathy Post
5 Office Building.
