A BILL

To provide support for the Daniel Patrick Moynihan Global Affairs Institute.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Daniel Patrick Moy-
5 nihan Global Affairs Institute Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

1 (1) ENDOWMENT FUND.—The term “endow-
2 ment fund” means a fund established by the Syra-
3 cuse University in Syracuse, New York, for the pur-
4 pose of generating income for the support of the
5 School.

6 (2) SCHOOL.—The term “School” means the
7 Daniel Patrick Moynihan Global Affairs Institute as
8 redesignated under this Act.

9 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
10 the Secretary of Education.

11 (4) UNIVERSITY.—The term “University”
12 means the Syracuse University in Syracuse, New
13 York.

14 **SEC. 3. DANIEL PATRICK MOYNIHAN GLOBAL AFFAIRS IN-**
15 **STITUTE.**

16 (a) REDESIGNATION.—To be eligible for a grant
17 under section 4, the University shall designate the global
18 affairs institute within the Maxwell School of Citizenship
19 and Public Affairs of the University as the “Daniel Pat-
20 rick Moynihan Global Affairs Institute”.

21 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
22 ulation, paper, or other record to the global affairs insti-
23 tute within the Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public
24 Affairs of the University, shall be deemed to be a reference
25 to the Daniel Patrick Moynihan Global Affairs Institute.

1 **SEC. 4. GRANT FOR ENDOWMENT FUND.**

2 From amounts appropriated under section 7, the Sec-
3 retary may award a grant to the University for the estab-
4 lishment of an endowment fund to support the Daniel Pat-
5 rick Moynihan Global Affairs Institute.

6 **SEC. 5. DUTIES.**

7 Amounts received under a grant under section 4,
8 shall be used to—

9 (1) carry on the public and intellectual tradition
10 of Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan;

11 (2) sustain all of the core activities of the
12 School;

13 (3) fund the residencies of visiting scholars and
14 international leaders;

15 (4) support scholarship, training, and practice
16 in countries that are often the most impoverished
17 economically, institutionally, and civically;

18 (5) support partnerships with governments and
19 other relevant entities around the world to train gov-
20 ernment officials both at the School and in their
21 home countries; and

22 (6) expand the facilities of the School.

23 **SEC. 6. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE**
24 **ENDOWMENT FUND.**

25 (a) **MANAGEMENT.**—The endowment fund estab-
26 lished under section 4 shall be managed in accordance

1 with the standard endowment policies established by the
2 University.

3 (b) USE OF INTEREST AND INVESTMENT INCOME.—
4 Interest and other investment income earned from the en-
5 dowment fund may be used to carry out the duties under
6 section 5.

7 (c) DISTRIBUTION OF INTEREST AND INVESTMENT
8 INCOME.—Funds derived from the interest and other in-
9 vestment income earned from the endowment fund shall
10 be available for expenditure by the University for purposes
11 consistent with section 5.

12 **SEC. 7. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

13 There is authorized to be appropriated to carry out
14 this Act, \$10,000,000 to remain available until expended.
