A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the National Bone Marrow Donor Registry, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “National Bone Marrow*
 5 *Donor Registry Reauthorization Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL BONE MARROW DONOR REGISTRY.**

7 *(a) NATIONAL REGISTRY.—Section 379 of the Public*
 8 *Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 274k) is amended—*

9 *(1) in subsection (a)—*

10 *(A) in paragraph (1), by striking “except*
 11 *that” and all that follows and inserting “except*
 12 *that—*

13 *“(A) such limitations shall not apply to the*
 14 *Chair of the board (or the Chair-elect) or to the*
 15 *member of the board who most recently served as*
 16 *the Chair; and*

17 *“(B) 1 additional consecutive 2-year term*
 18 *may be served by any member of the board who*
 19 *has no employment, governance, or financial af-*
 20 *filiation with any donor center, recruitment*
 21 *group, transplant center, or cord blood bank.”;*
 22 *and*

23 *(B) in paragraph (4)—*

24 *(i) by striking “the Naval Medical Re-*
 25 *search and Development Command” and*

1 *inserting “the Department of Defense Mar-*
2 *row Donor Recruitment and Research Pro-*
3 *gram operated by the Department of the*
4 *Navy”; and*

5 *(ii) by striking “Organ” after “Divi-*
6 *sion of”;*

7 *(2) in subsection (b)—*

8 *(A) in paragraph (4), by inserting “at*
9 *least” before “annually”;*

10 *(B) in paragraph (7), by striking “and*
11 *comparisons of transplant centers regarding*
12 *search and other costs that prior to transplan-*
13 *tation are charged to patients by transplant cen-*
14 *ters; and”;*

15 *(C) in paragraph (8), by inserting “and*
16 *outreach” after “and demonstration”;*

17 *(D) at the end of paragraph (8), by striking*
18 *the period and inserting a semicolon;*

19 *(E) by redesignating paragraphs (3)*
20 *through (8) as paragraphs (4) through (9);*

21 *(F) by inserting after paragraph (2), the*
22 *following:*

23 *“(3) maintain and expand medical emergency*
24 *contingency response capabilities in concert with Fed-*
25 *eral programs for response to threats of use of ter-*

1 *rorist or military weapons that can damage marrow,*
2 *such as ionizing radiation or chemical agents con-*
3 *taining mustard, so that the capability of supporting*
4 *patients with marrow damage from disease can be*
5 *used to support casualties with marrow damage;”;*
6 *and*

7 *(G) by adding at the end the following:*

8 *“(10) conduct and support research to improve*
9 *the availability, efficiency, safety, and cost of trans-*
10 *plants from unrelated donors and the effectiveness of*
11 *Registry operations;*

12 *“(11) increase the number of umbilical cord*
13 *blood units listed in the Registry and assist cord*
14 *blood banks in the Registry program in accordance*
15 *with subsection (c); and*

16 *“(12) establish bylaws and procedures—*

17 *“(A) to prohibit any member of the board of*
18 *directors of the Registry who has an employ-*
19 *ment, governance, or financial affiliation with a*
20 *donor center, recruitment group, transplant cen-*
21 *ter, or cord blood bank from participating in*
22 *any decision that materially affects the center,*
23 *recruitment group, transplant center, or cord*
24 *blood bank; and*

1 “(B) to limit the number of members of the
2 board with any such affiliation.”;

3 (3) in subsection (c)—

4 (A) in clause (ii) of paragraph (2)(A), by
5 striking “, including providing updates”; and

6 (B) in paragraph (3), by striking “the
7 availability, as a potential treatment option, of
8 receiving a transplant of bone marrow from an
9 unrelated donor” and inserting “transplants
10 from unrelated donors as a treatment option and
11 resources for identifying and evaluating other
12 therapeutic alternatives”;

13 (4) in subsection (d)—

14 (A) in paragraph (2)(C), by inserting “and
15 assist with information regarding third party
16 payor matters” after “ongoing search for a
17 donor”;

18 (B) in paragraph (2)(F)—

19 (i) by redesignating clause (v) as
20 clause (vi); and

21 (ii) by inserting after clause (iv) the
22 following:

23 “(v) Information concerning issues
24 that patients may face after a transplant

1 *regarding continuity of care and quality of*
2 *life.”; and*

3 *(C) in paragraph (3)(B), by striking “Of-*
4 *fice may” and inserting “Office shall”;*

5 *(5) in subsection (g), by striking “the bone mar-*
6 *row donor program of the Department of the Navy”*
7 *and inserting “the Department of Defense Marrow*
8 *Donor Recruitment and Research Program operated*
9 *by the Department of the Navy”;*

10 *(6) in subsection (h)—*

11 *(A) by striking “APPLICATION.—” and in-*
12 *serting “CONTRACTS.—”;*

13 *(B) by striking “To be eligible” and insert-*
14 *ing the following:*

15 *“(1) APPLICATION.—To be eligible”; and*

16 *(C) by adding at the end the following:*

17 *“(2) CONSIDERATIONS.—In awarding contracts*
18 *under this section, the Secretary shall give substantial*
19 *weight to the continued safety of donors and patients*
20 *and other factors deemed appropriate by the Sec-*
21 *retary.”;*

22 *(7) in subsection (i), by striking “include” and*
23 *inserting “be”; and*

24 *(8) by striking subsection (l).*

1 (b) *BONE MARROW SCIENTIFIC REGISTRY*.—Section
2 379A of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 274l) is
3 amended—

4 (1) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the
5 following: “The scientific registry shall participate in
6 medical research that has the potential to improve
7 transplant outcomes.”;

8 (2) in subsection (c), by striking “Each such re-
9 port shall in addition include the data required in
10 section 379(l) (relating to pretransplant costs).”; and

11 (3) by adding after subsection (c) the following:
12 “(d) *PUBLICLY AVAILABLE DATA*.—The scientific reg-
13 istry shall make relevant scientific information not con-
14 taining individually identifiable information available to
15 the public in the form of summaries and data sets to encour-
16 age medical research and to provide information to trans-
17 plant programs, physicians, and patients.”.

18 (c) *BONE MARROW AND MARROW DEFINED*.—Part I
19 of title III of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 274k
20 et seq.) is amended—

21 (1) by redesignating section 379B as section
22 379C; and

23 (2) by inserting after section 379A the following:

1 **“SEC. 379B. BONE MARROW AND MARROW DEFINED.**

2 *“For purposes of this part, the terms ‘bone marrow’*
 3 *and ‘marrow’ include bone marrow and any other source*
 4 *of hematopoietic progenitor cells the acquisition or use of*
 5 *which is not inconsistent with Federal law.”.*

6 (d) *AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section*
 7 *379C of the Public Health Service Act, as redesignated by*
 8 *subsection (c), is amended to read as follows:*

9 **“SEC. 379C. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

10 *“(a) IN GENERAL.—For the purpose of carrying out*
 11 *this part, there are authorized to be appropriated*
 12 *\$32,000,000 for fiscal year 2004, and such sums as may*
 13 *be necessary for each of the fiscal years 2005 through 2008.*

14 *“(b) EMERGENCY CONTINGENCY RESPONSE CAPABILI-*
 15 *TIES.—In addition to the amounts authorized to be appro-*
 16 *priated under subsection (a), there are authorized to be ap-*
 17 *propriated such sums as may be necessary for the mainte-*
 18 *nance and expansion of emergency contingency response ca-*
 19 *pabilities under section 379(b)(3).”.*

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
