# A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the National Bone Marrow Donor Registry, and for other purposes.

4	This Act may be cited as the "National Bone Marrow					
5	Donor Registry Reauthorization Act".					
6	SEC. 2. NATIONAL BONE MARROW DONOR REGISTRY.					
7	7 (a) National Registry.—Section 379 of the Pub					
8	Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 274k) is amended—

11	that" and all that follows and inserting "except

20	filiation with any donor center, recruitment					
21	group, transplant center, or cord blood bank.";

1	(b) Bone Marrow Scientific Registry.—Section					
2	379A of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 274l) is					
3	amended—					
4	(1) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the					
5	following: "The scientific registry shall participate in					
6	medical research that has the potential to improv					
7	transplant outcomes.";					
8	(2) in subsection (c), by striking "Each such re-					
9	port shall in addition include the data required i					
10	section 379(l) (relating to pretransplant costs)."; and					
11	(3) by adding after subsection (c) the following					
12	"(d) Publicly Available Data.—The scientific reg-					
13	istry shall make relevant scientific information not con-					
14	taining individually identifiable information available to					
15	the public in the form of summaries and data sets to encour-					
16	age medical research and to provide information to trans-					
17	plant programs, physicians, and patients.".					
18	(c) Bone Marrow and Marrow Defined.—Part I					
19	of title III of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 274k					
20	et seq.) is amended—					
21	(1) by redesignating section 379B as section					
22	379C; and					
23	(2) by inserting after section 379A the following:					

#### 1 "SEC. 379B. BONE MARROW AND MARROW DEFINED.

- 2 "For purposes of this part, the terms bone marrow"
- 3 and 'marrow' include bone marrow and any other source
- 4 of hematopoietic progenitor cells the acquisition or use of
- 5 which is not inconsistent with Federal law.".
- 6 (d) Authorization of Appropriations.—Section
- 7 379C of the Public Health Service Act, as redesignated by
- 8 subsection (c), is amended to read as follows:
- 9 "SEC. 379C. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
- 10 "(a) In General.—For the purpose of carrying out
- 11 this part, there are authorized to be appropriated
- 12 \$32,000,000 for fiscal year 2004, and such sums as may
- 13 be necessary for each of the fiscal years 2005 through 2008.
- 14 "(b) Emergency Contingency Response Capabili-
- 15 Ties.—In addition to the amounts authorized to be appro-
- 16 priated under subsection (a), there are authorized to be ap-
- 17 propriated such sums as may be necessary for the mainte-
- 18 nance and expansion of emergency contingency response ca-
- 19 pabilities under section 379(b)(3).".

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
