- 4 COASTAL BARRIER RESOURCES SYSTEM
- 5 MAPS.
- 6 (a) In General.—The 2 maps subtitled "P25/
- 7 P25P", relating to the John H. Chafee Coastal Barrier
- 8 Resources System unit designated as Coastal Barrier Re-
- 9 sources System Cedar Keys Unit P25/P25P, that are in-
- 10 cluded in the set of maps entitled "Coastal Barrier Re-

- 1 sources System" and referred to in section 4(a) of the
- 2 Coast Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)), are
- 3 hereby replaced by 2 other maps relating to those units
- 4 entitled "John H. Chafee Coastal Barrier Resources Sys-
- 5 tem Cedar Keys Unit P25/P25P" and dated September
- 6 10, 2003.
- 7 (b) Availability.—the Secretary of the Interior
- 8 shall keep the maps referred to in subsection (a) on file
- 9 and available for inspection in accordance with the provi-
- 10 sions of section 4(b) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act
- 11 (16 U.S.C. 3503(b)).
