AN ACT

To clarify the boundaries of the John H. Chafee Coast
Barrier Resources System Cedar Keys Unit P25 on Oth-
erwise Protected Area P25P.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF CERTAIN JOHN H. CHAFEE**
2 **COASTAL BARRIER RESOURCES SYSTEM MAP.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Of the 2 maps subtitled “P25/
4 P25P” that relate to the John H. Chafee Coastal Barrier
5 Resources System unit designated as Coastal Barrier Re-
6 sources System Cedar Keys Unit P25/P25P and are in-
7 cluded in the set of maps entitled “Coastal Barrier Re-
8 sources System” referred to in section 4(a) of the Coastal
9 Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)), the map de-
10 picting the northernmost area of that unit is hereby re-
11 placed by another map relating to that unit entitled “John
12 H. Chafee Coastal Barrier Resources System Cedar Keys
13 Unit P25/P25P” and dated February 9, 2004.

14 (b) AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary of the Interior
15 shall keep the replacement map referred to in subsection
16 (a) on file and available for inspection in accordance with
17 section 4(b) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16
18 U.S.C. 3503(b)).
