A BILL

To authorize appropriations for the Coastal Heritage Trail Route in New Jersey, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR**
4 **COASTAL HERITAGE TRAIL ROUTE IN NEW**
5 **JERSEY.**

6 (a) REAUTHORIZATION.—Section 6 of Public Law
7 100–515 (16 U.S.C. 1244 note) is amended—

8 (1) in subsection (b)(1), by striking
9 “\$4,000,000” and inserting “\$8,000,000”; and

1 (2) in subsection (c), by striking “10” and in-
2 serting “15”.

3 (b) STRATEGIC PLAN.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Inte-
5 rior shall, by not later than 4 years after the date
6 of the enactment of this Act, prepare a strategic
7 plan for the New Jersey Coastal Heritage Trail
8 Route.

9 (2) CONTENTS.—The strategic plan shall de-
10 scribe—

11 (A) opportunities to increase participation
12 by national and local private and public inter-
13 ests in planning, development, and administra-
14 tion of the New Jersey Coastal Heritage Trail
15 Route; and

16 (B) organizational options for sustaining
17 the New Jersey Coastal Heritage Trail Route.

18 (c) GRANTS.—Public Law 100–515 (16 U.S.C. 1244
19 note) is amended—

20 (1) by inserting “and grants (subject to the
21 availability of appropriations)” after “technical as-
22 sistance”; and

23 (2) in section 6(b)(2) by inserting “and grants”
24 after “technical assistance”.
