- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Internal Revenue Code of
- 6 1986 shall be applied without regard to the Convention
- 7 between the United States of America and Barbados for
- 8 the Avoidance of Double Taxation and the Prevention of
- 9 Fiscal Evasion with Respect to Taxes on Income signed
- 10 on December 31, 1984.
- 11 (b) Effective Date.—Subsection (a) shall apply—

1	(1) in the case of United States taxes withheld
2	at source, to amounts paid or credited after the date
3	of the enactment of this Act, and
4	(2) in the case of other United States taxes, to
5	taxable years ending after such date
