AN ACT

To extend certain hydro-electric licenses in the State of
Alaska.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. STAY AND REINSTATEMENT OF FERC LICENSE**

2 **NO. 11393.**

3 (a) Upon the request of the licensee for FERC
4 Project No. 11393, the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
5 mission shall issue an order staying the license.

6 (b) Upon the request of the licensee for FERC
7 Project No. 11393, but not later than 6 years after the
8 date that the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission re-
9 ceives written notice that construction of the Swan-Tyee
10 transmission line is completed, the Federal Energy Regu-
11 latory Commission shall issue an order lifting the stay and
12 make the effective date of the license the date on which
13 the stay is lifted.

14 (c) Upon request of the licensee for FERC Project
15 No. 11393 and notwithstanding the time period specified
16 in section 13 of the Federal Power Act for the commence-
17 ment of construction, the Commission shall, after reason-
18 able notice and in accordance with the good faith, due dili-
19 gence, and public interest requirements of that section, ex-
20 tend the time period during which licensee is required to

1 commence the construction of the project for not more
2 than one 2-year time period.
