3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION OF FACILITY.**

4 The facility of the Bureau of Reclamation located at
5 15990 Kelso Road in Byron, California, and known as the
6 Tracy Pumping Plant, shall be known and designated as
7 the “C.W. ‘Bill’ Jones Pumping Plant”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper or other record of the United States to the facility
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “C.W. ‘Bill’ Jones Pumping Plant”.
