A BILL

To provide for the correct treatment of territories and possessions in the health care service supports under the Communications Act of 1934.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Pacific Insular Areas
- 5 Rural Telemedicine Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FCC REGULATIONS REQUIRED.
- 7 Section 254(h)(1)(A) of the Communications Act of
- 8 1934 (47 U.S.C. 254(h)(1)(A)) is amended by adding at
- 9 the end the following new sentence: "For the purposes of

- 1 this subparagraph for American Samoa, the Common-
- 2 wealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and Guam, the
- 3 Commission shall by regulation (i) designate Honolulu,
- 4 Hawaii, as the urban area that shall be treated as if such
- 5 urban area were in the same State as the rural areas of
- 6 Guam, American Samoa, or the Commonwealth of the
- 7 Northern Mariana Islands, respectively; (ii) specify that
- 8 the maximum allowable distance shall be the distance be-
- 9 tween the capital cities of these Pacific insular areas and
- 10 Hawaii; and (iii) specify that the urban rate shall be based
- 11 on the urban rate for Hawaii.".
