Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. AVAILABILITY OF NOAA REAL PROPERTY ON
 VIRGINIA KEY, FLORIDA.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Commerce may
6 make available to the University of Miami real property
7 under the administrative jurisdiction of the National Oce8 anic and Atmospheric Administration on Virginia Key,
9 Florida, for development by the University of a Marine
10 Life Science Center.

(b) MANNER OF AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary may
make property available under this section by easement,
lease, license, or long-term agreement with the University.
(c) AUTHORIZED USES BY UNIVERSITY.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Property made available
under this section may be used by the University
(subject to paragraph (2)) to develop and operate facilities for multidisciplinary environmental and fisheries research, assessment, management, and educational activities.

(2) AGREEMENT.—Property made available
under this section may not be used by the University
(including any affiliate of the University) except in
accordance with an agreement with the Secretary
that—

1	(A) specifies—
2	(i) the conditions for non-Federal use
3	of the property; and
4	(ii) the retained Federal interests in
5	the property, including interests in access
6	to and egress from the property by Federal
7	personnel and preservation of existing
8	rights-of-way;
9	(B) establishes conditions for joint occu-
10	pancy of buildings and other facilities on the
11	property by the University and Federal agen-
12	cies; and
13	(C) includes provisions that ensure—
14	(i) that there is no diminishment of
15	existing National Oceanic and Atmospheric
16	Administration programs and services at
17	Virginia Key; and
18	(ii) the availability of the property for
19	planning, development, and construction of
20	future Federal buildings and facilities.
21	(3) TERMINATION OF AVAILABILITY.—The
22	availability of property under this section shall ter-
23	minate immediately upon use of the property by the
24	University—

1	(A) for any purpose other than as de-
2	scribed in paragraph (1); or
3	(B) in violation of the agreement under
4	paragraph (2).
5	(d) Use of Facilities by Secretary.—The Sec-
6	retary may—
7	(1) subject to the availability of funding, enter
8	into an agreement to occupy facilities constructed by
9	the University on property made available under this
10	section; and
11	(2) participate with the University in collabo-
12	rative research at, or administered through, such fa-
13	cilities.
14	(e) NO CONVEYANCE OF TITLE.—This section shall
15	not be construed to convey or authorize conveyance of any
16	interest of the United States in title to property made
17	available under this section.
