Ms. BORDALLO introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To amend subchapter IV of chapter 53 of title 5, United
States Code, to provide for wage parity for prevailing
rate employees in Guam.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PARITY OF WAGE SCHEDULES AND RATES FOR**
4 **PREVAILING RATE EMPLOYEES IN GUAM**
5 **WITH WAGE SCHEDULES AND RATES FOR**
6 **PREVAILING RATE EMPLOYEES IN HAWAII.**

7 Section 5343(a) of title 5, United States Code, is
8 amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (3), by striking “subject to
2 paragraph (5)” and inserting “subject to paragraphs
3 (5) and (6)”;

4 (2) in paragraph (4), by striking “; and” and
5 inserting a semicolon;

6 (3) in paragraph (5), by striking the period and
7 inserting “; and”; and

8 (4) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(6) the Office of Personnel Management shall
10 establish wage schedules and rates for prevailing
11 rate employees who are United States citizens em-
12 ployed in Guam that are the same as the wage
13 schedules and rates for prevailing rate employees in
14 Hawaii.”.

15 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

16 This Act shall be effective with respect to pay periods
17 commencing in any fiscal year that commences at least
18 6 months after the date of the enactment of this Act.
