## A BILL

- To authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2005 for intelligence and intelligence-related activities of the United States Government, the Community Management Account, and the Central Intelligence Agency Retirement and Disability System, and for other purposes.

#### **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Intelligence Authoriza-
- 5 tion Act for Fiscal Year 2005".

### TITLE I—INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES

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#### 3 SEC. 101. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

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Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for
fiscal year 2005 for the conduct of the intelligence and
intelligence-related activities of the following elements of
the United States Government:

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8	(1) The Central Intelligence Agency.
9	(2) The Department of Defense.
10	(3) The Defense Intelligence Agency.
11	(4) The National Security Agency.
12	(5) The Department of the Army, the Depart-
13	ment of the Navy, and the Department of the Air
14	Force.
15	(6) The Department of State.
16	(7) The Department of the Treasury.
17	(8) The Department of Energy.
18	(9) The Department of Justice.
19	(10) The Federal Bureau of Investigation.
20	(11) The National Reconnaissance Office.
21	(12) The National Geospatial-Intelligence Agen-
22	cy.
23	(13) The Coast Guard.
24	(14) The Department of Homeland Security.

#### 1 SEC. 102. CLASSIFIED SCHEDULE OF AUTHORIZATIONS.

2 (a) Specifications of Amounts and Personnel 3 CEILINGS.—The amounts authorized to be appropriated under section 101, and the authorized personnel ceilings 4 5 as of September 30, 2005, for the conduct of the intelligence and intelligence-related activities of the elements 6 7 listed in such section, are those specified in the classified 8 Schedule of Authorizations prepared to accompany the bill 9 H.R. of the One Hundred Eighth Congress.

10 (b) AVAILABILITY OF CLASSIFIED SCHEDULE OF AU-11 THORIZATIONS.—The Schedule of Authorizations shall be 12 made available to the Committees on Appropriations of 13 the Senate and House of Representatives and to the Presi-14 dent. The President shall provide for suitable distribution 15 of the Schedule, or of appropriate portions of the Sched-16 ule, within the executive branch.

#### 17 SEC. 103. PERSONNEL CEILING ADJUSTMENTS.

18 (a) AUTHORITY FOR ADJUSTMENTS.—With the ap-19 proval of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, the Director of Central Intelligence may authorize 2021 employment of civilian personnel in excess of the number 22 authorized for fiscal year 2005 under section 102 when 23 the Director of Central Intelligence determines that such 24 action is necessary to the performance of important intelligence functions. 25

(b) NOTICE TO INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEES.—The
 Director of Central Intelligence shall notify promptly the
 Select Committee on Intelligence of the Senate and the
 Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the House
 of Representatives whenever the Director exercises the au thority granted by this section.

## 7 SEC. 104. INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY MANAGEMENT AC8 COUNT.

9 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is 10 authorized to be appropriated for the Intelligence Community Management Account of the Director of Central Intel-11 ligence for fiscal year 2005 the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_. 12 13 Within such amount, funds identified in the classified Schedule of Authorizations referred to in section 102(a)14 15 for advanced research and development shall remain available until September 30, 2006. 16

17 (b) AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL LEVELS.—The elements within the Intelligence Community Management 18 Account of the Director of Central Intelligence are author-19 20 ized full-time personnel as of September 30, 2005. 21 Personnel serving in such elements may be permanent em-22 ployees of the Intelligence Community Management Ac-23 count or personnel detailed from other elements of the 24United States Government.

25 (c) Classified Authorizations.—

1 (1) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—In 2 addition to amounts authorized to be appropriated 3 for the Intelligence Community Management Ac-4 count by subsection (a), there are also authorized to 5 be appropriated for the Intelligence Community 6 Management Account for fiscal year 2005 such addi-7 tional amounts as are specified in the classified 8 Schedule of Authorizations referred to in section 9 102(a). Such additional amounts for advanced research and development shall remain available until 10 11 September 30, 2006.

(2) AUTHORIZATION OF PERSONNEL.—In addition to the personnel authorized by subsection (b)
for elements of the Intelligence Community Management Account as of September 30, 2005, there are
also authorized such additional personnel for such
elements as of that date as are specified in the classified Schedule of Authorizations.

(d) REIMBURSEMENT.—Except as provided in section
113 of the National Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C.
404h), during fiscal year 2005 any officer or employee of
the United States or a member of the Armed Forces who
is detailed to the staff of the Intelligence Community Management Account from another element of the United
States Government shall be detailed on a reimbursable

basis, except that any such officer, employee, or member
 may be detailed on a nonreimbursable basis for a period
 of less than one year for the performance of temporary
 functions as required by the Director of Central Intel ligence.

# 6 TITLE II—CENTRAL INTEL7 LIGENCE AGENCY RETIRE8 MENT AND DISABILITY SYS9 TEM

#### 10 SEC. 201. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

# 14 TITLE III—GENERAL 15 PROVISIONS

16 SEC. 301. INCREASE IN EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION AND

17 BENEFITS AUTHORIZED BY LAW.

Appropriations authorized by this Act for salary, pay, retirement, and other benefits for Federal employees may be increased by such additional or supplemental amounts as may be necessary for increases in such compensation or benefits authorized by law.

## 1SEC. 302. RESTRICTION ON CONDUCT OF INTELLIGENCE2ACTIVITIES.

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3 The authorization of appropriations by this Act shall
4 not be deemed to constitute authority for the conduct of
5 any intelligence activity which is not otherwise authorized
6 by the Constitution or the laws of the United States.
