 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. NATIONAL PLAN FOR CONTROL AND MANAGE 2 MENT OF SUDDEN OAK DEATH.

3 (a) DEVELOPMENT OF NATIONAL PLAN.—Subject to
4 the availability of appropriated funds for this purpose, the
5 Secretary of Agriculture, acting through the Animal Plant
6 and Health Inspection Service, shall develop a national
7 plan for the control and management of Sudden Oak
8 Death, a forest disease caused by the fungus-like pathogen
9 Phytophthora ramorum.

10 (b) PLAN ELEMENTS.—In developing the plan, the11 Secretary shall specifically address the following:

(1) Information derived by the Department of
Agriculture from ongoing efforts to identify hosts of
Phytophthora ramorum and survey the extent to
which Sudden Oak Death exists in the United
States.

(2) Past and current efforts to understand the
risk posed by Phytophthora ramorum and the results of control and management efforts regarding
Sudden Oak Death, including efforts related to research, control, quarantine, and hazardous fuel reduction.

23 (3) Such future efforts as the Secretary con24 siders necessary to control and manage Sudden Oak
25 Death, including cost estimates for the implementa26 tion of such efforts.

(c) CONSULTATION.—The Secretary shall develop the
 plan in consultation with other Federal agencies that have
 appropriate expertise regarding the control and manage ment of Sudden Oak Death.

5 (d) IMPLEMENTATION OF PLAN.—The Secretary
6 shall complete the plan and commence implementation as
7 soon as practicable after the date on which funds are first
8 appropriated pursuant to the authorization of appropria9 tions in subsection (e) to carry out this section.

(e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary such sums
as may be necessary to carry out this section.
