AN ACT

To amend section 340E of the Public Health Service Act (relating to children's hospitals) to modify provisions regarding the determination of the amount of payments for indirect expenses associated with operating approved graduate medical residency training programs.

7	(a) In General.—Section 340E(d) of the Public
8	Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 256e(d)) is amended—
9	(1) in paragraph (1), by striking "related to"
10	and inserting "associated with"; and
11	(2) in paragraph (2)(A)—
12	(A) by inserting "ratio of the" after "hos-
13	pitals and the"; and
14	(B) by inserting at the end before the
15	semicolon "to beds (but excluding beds or bassi-
16	nets assigned to healthy newborn infants)".
17	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
18	subsection (a) shall apply to payments for periods begin-
19	ning with fiscal year 2005.
