3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Teacher Training Ex-
5 pansion Act of 2004”.

1 **SEC. 2. PREFERENCES ALLOWED IN DISTRIBUTION OF CER-**
2 **TAIN GRANTS.**

3 Section 673(g)(3) of the Individuals with Disabilities
4 Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1473(g)(3)) is amended—

5 (1) at the end of subparagraph (A) by striking
6 “and”;

7 (2) at the end of subparagraph (B) by striking
8 the period and inserting “; and”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
10 paragraph:

11 “(C) give preference to local educational
12 agencies and public or private nonprofit organi-
13 zations that provide training to regular edu-
14 cation personnel to meet the needs of children
15 with disabilities in integrated settings and pro-
16 vide training to regular education personnel to
17 work in collaboration with special education
18 personnel in integrated settings.”.
