A BILL

For the relief of Tanya Andrea Goudeau.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IMMEDIATE RELATIVE STATUS FOR TANYA AN-**

4 **DREA GOUDEAU.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Tanya Andrea Goudeau shall be
6 classified as a child under section 101(b)(1)(E) of the Im-
7 migration and Nationality Act for purposes of approval
8 of a relative visa petition filed under section 204 of such

1 Act by her adoptive parent and the filing of an application
2 for an immigrant visa or adjustment of status.

3 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Tanya Andrea
4 Goudeau enters the United States before the filing dead-
5 line specified in subsection (c), she shall be considered to
6 have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise
7 eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under section
8 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date
9 of the enactment of this Act.

10 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
11 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the pe-
12 tition and the application for issuance of an immigrant
13 visa or the application for adjustment of status are filed
14 with appropriate fees within 2 years after the date of the
15 enactment of this Act.

16 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
17 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
18 idence to Tanya Andrea Goudeau, the Secretary of State
19 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, for the
20 current or next following fiscal year, the worldwide level
21 of family-sponsored immigrants under section
22 201(c)(1)(A) of the Immigration and Nationality Act.

23 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION
24 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural
25 parents, brothers, and sisters of Tanya Andrea Goudeau

1 shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any
2 right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and Na-
3 tionality Act.

4 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY FOR CITIZENSHIP.**

5 For purposes of section 320 of the Immigration and
6 Nationality Act, Tanya Andrea Goudeau shall be consid-
7 ered to have satisfied the requirements applicable to
8 adopted children under section 101(b)(1) of such Act.
