1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF RESERVATION OF MINERAL**
2 **RIGHTS, LIVINGSTON PARISH, LOUISIANA.**

3 Section 102 of Public Law 102–562 (106 Stat. 4234)
4 is amended—

- 5 (1) by striking “(a) IN GENERAL.—”;
- 6 (2) by striking “and subject to the reservation
7 in subsection (b),”; and
- 8 (3) by striking subsection (b).

9 **SEC. 2. IMPLEMENTATION OF AMENDMENT.**

10 The Secretary of the Interior shall execute the legal
11 instruments necessary to effectuate the amendment made
12 by subsection (a)(3) of section 1.
