1 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF RESERVATION OF MINERAL**
2 **RIGHTS, LIVINGSTON PARISH, LOUISIANA.**

3 (a) AMENDMENTS.—Section 102 of Public Law 102–
4 562 (106 Stat. 4234) is amended—

5 (1) by striking “(a) IN GENERAL.—”;

6 (2) by striking “and subject to the reservation
7 in subsection (b),”; and

8 (3) by striking subsection (b).

9 (b) IMPLEMENTATION OF AMENDMENT.—The Sec-
10 retary of the Interior shall execute the legal instruments
11 necessary to effectuate the amendment made by sub-
12 section (a)(3).
