Mr. YOUNG of Alaska introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To make technical corrections relating to the Coast Guard
and Maritime Transportation Act of 2004.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Coast Guard and Mari-
5 time Transportation Technical Corrections Act of 2004”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENTS FOR COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS**

7 **FOR VOLUNTARY SERVICES.**

8 Section 93(a)(19) of title 14, United States Code, as
9 amended by section 201 of the Coast Guard and Maritime
10 Transportation Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–293; 118

1 Stat. 1031), is amended by redesignating subparagraphs
2 (1) and (2) in order as subparagraphs (A) and (B).

3 **SEC. 3. CORRECTION OF AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER ANAL-**
4 **YSIS.**

5 Section 212(b) of the Coast Guard and Maritime
6 Transportation Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–293; 118
7 Stat. 1037) is amended by inserting “of title 14” after
8 “chapter 17”.

9 **SEC. 4. RECOMMENDATIONS TO CONGRESS BY COM-**
10 **MANDANT OF THE COAST GUARD.**

11 Section 93(a) of title 14, United States Code, as
12 amended by sections 201 and 217 of the Coast Guard and
13 Maritime Transportation Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–
14 293; 118 Stat. 1031, 1038), is amended by redesignating
15 paragraph (y) as paragraph (24).

16 **SEC. 5. DETERMINING ADEQUACY OF POTABLE WATER.**

17 Section 3305(a) of title 46, United States Code, as
18 amended by section 416(b)(3) of the Coast Guard and
19 Maritime Transportation Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–
20 293; 118 Stat. 1047), is amended by moving paragraph
21 (2) two ems to the left, so that the material preceding
22 subparagraph (A) of such paragraph aligns with the left-
23 hand margin of paragraph (1) of such section.

1 **SEC. 6. RENEWAL OF ADVISORY GROUP.**

2 Section 418(a) of the Coast Guard and Maritime
3 Transportation Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–293; 118
4 Stat. 1049) is amended by striking “of September 30,
5 2005” and inserting “on September 30, 2005”.

6 **SEC. 7. VESSEL RESPONSE PLANS.**

7 Section 311 of the Federal Water Pollution Control
8 Act (33 U.S.C. 1321), as amended by section 701 of the
9 Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation Act of 2004
10 (Public Law 108–293; 118 Stat. 1067), is amended by
11 striking “non-tank” each place it appears and inserting
12 “nontank”.

13 **SEC. 8. CORRECTION TO SUBTITLE DESIGNATION.**

14 (a) REDESIGNATION.—Title 46, United States Code,
15 is amended by redesignating subtitle VI as subtitle VII.

16 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of subtitles
17 at the beginning of title 46, United States Code, is amend-
18 ed by striking the item relating to subtitle VI and insert-
19 ing the following:

“VII. MISCELLANEOUS 70101”.

20 **SEC. 9. CORRECTIONS TO CHAPTER 701 OF TITLE 46,**
21 **UNITED STATES CODE.**

22 Chapter 701 of title 46, United States Code, is
23 amended as follows:

24 (1) Sections 70118 and 70119, as added by
25 section 801 of the Coast Guard and Maritime

1 Transportation Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–293;
2 118 Stat. 1078), are redesignated as sections 70117
3 and 70118, respectively, and moved to appear imme-
4 diately after section 70116 of title 46, United States
5 Code.

6 (2) Sections 70117 and 70118, as added by
7 section 802 of such Act (Public Law 108–293; 118
8 Stat. 1078), are redesignated as sections 70120 and
9 70121, respectively, and moved to appear imme-
10 diately after section 70119 of title 46, United States
11 Code.

12 (3) In section 70120(a), as redesignated by
13 paragraph (2) of this section, by striking “section
14 70120” and inserting “section 70119”.

15 (4) In section 70121(a), as redesignated by
16 paragraph (2) of this section, by striking “section
17 70120” and inserting “section 70119”.

18 (5) In the analysis at the beginning of the
19 chapter, by striking the items relating to sections
20 70117 through the second 70119 and inserting the
21 following:

- “70117. Firearms, arrests, and seizure of property.
- “70118. Enforcement by State and local officers.
- “70119. Civil penalty.
- “70120. In rem liability for civil penalties and certain costs.
- “70121. Withholding of clearance.”.

1 **SEC. 10. TECHNICAL CORRECTION REGARDING TANK VES-**
2 **SEL ENVIRONMENTAL EQUIVALENCY EVAL-**
3 **UATION INDEX.**

4 Section 4115(e)(3) of the Oil Pollution Act of 1990
5 (46 U.S.C. 3703a note) is amended by striking “hull” the
6 second place it appears.

7 **SEC. 11. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

8 This Act shall take effect August 9, 2004.
