A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exclude from gross income certain death gratuity payments to members of the uniformed services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Military Death Gra-
5 tuity Improvement Act of 2003”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXCLUSION FROM GROSS INCOME OF CERTAIN**
2 **DEATH GRATUITY PAYMENTS TO MEMBERS**
3 **OF UNIFORMED SERVICES.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Paragraph (3) of section 134(b)
5 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to certain
6 military benefits) is amended by adding at the end the
7 following new subparagraph:

8 “(C) **EXCEPTION FOR DEATH GRATUITY**
9 **INCREASE.**—Subparagraph (A) shall be applied
10 by substituting ‘December 31, 1991’ for ‘Sep-
11 tember 9, 1986’ in the case of a death gratuity
12 payable under chapter 75 of title 10, United
13 States Code, with respect to a death occurring
14 after September 10, 2001.”.

15 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Subparagraph (A)
16 of section 134(b)(3) of such Code is amended by striking
17 “subparagraph (B)” and inserting “subparagraphs (B)
18 and (C)”.

19 (c) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
20 this section shall apply to amounts paid with respect to
21 deaths occurring after September 10, 2001.
