3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-
5 cated at 111 West Washington Street in Bowling Green,

1 Ohio, shall be known and designated as the “Delbert L.
2 Latta Post Office Building”.

3 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

4 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
5 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility
6 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
7 to the Delbert L. Latta Post Office Building.
