Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6) to enhance energy conservation and research and development, to provide for security and diversity in the energy supply for the American people, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 6) to enhance energy conservation

1 and research and development, to provide for security and
2 diversity in the energy supply for the American people,
3 and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall
4 be dispensed with. All points of order against consider-
5 ation of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
6 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour and 30
7 minutes, with 30 minutes equally divided and controlled
8 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
9 Committee on Energy and Commerce, and 20 minutes
10 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
11 ing minority member of each of the Committees on
12 Science, Resources, and Ways and Means. After general
13 debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under
14 the five-minute rule. The bill shall be considered as read.
15 No amendment shall be in order except those printed in
16 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
17 resolution. Each amendment may be offered only in the
18 order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Mem-
19 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,
20 shall be debatable for the time specified in the report
21 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
22 opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
23 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
24 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points
25 of order against such amendments are waived. At the con-

1 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
2 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
3 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
4 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
5 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
6 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
7 structions.
