Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 17) to provide economic security for America's workers.

IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

Mr. MICHAUD submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 17) to provide economic security for America's workers.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the State of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 17) to provide economic security
6 for America's workers. The first reading of the bill shall
7 be dispensed with. All points of order against consider-
8 ation of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
9 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
10 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-

1 ity member of the Committee on Ways and Means. After
2 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
3 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider
4 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under
5 the five-minute rule an amendment in the nature of a sub-
6 stitute printed in the Congressional Record pursuant to
7 clause 8 of rule XVIII by the ranking minority member
8 of the Committee on Ways and Means. That amendment
9 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read.
10 All points of order against that amendment in the nature
11 of a substitute are waived (except those arising under
12 clause 7 of rule XVI). No amendment to that amendment
13 in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except a
14 further amendment in the nature of a substitute offered
15 by the chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means
16 or his designee. That amendment shall be considered as
17 read, shall be debatable for one hour equally divided and
18 controlled by the proponent and an opponent, and shall
19 not be subject to amendment. All points of order against
20 that amendment are waived (except those arising under
21 clause 7 of rule XVI). At the conclusion of consideration
22 of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and
23 report the bill to the House with such amendments as may
24 have been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate
25 vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Com-

1 mittee of the Whole to the bill or to the amendment in
2 the nature of a substitute made in order as original text.
3 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
4 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
5 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
6 or without instructions.

7 SEC. 2. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-
8 ports that it has come to no resolution on the bill, then
9 on the next legislative day the House shall, immediately
10 after the third daily order of business under clause 1 of
11 rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the Whole for fur-
12 ther consideration of the bill.
