Mr. MARSHALL submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 303) to amend title 10, United States Code, to permit retired members of the Armed Forces who have a service-connected disability to receive both military retired pay by reason of their years of military service and disability compensation from the Department of Veterans Affairs for their disability.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution the House shall without intervention of any
3 point of order consider in the House the bill (H.R. 303)
4 to amend title 10, United States Code, to permit retired
5 members of the Armed Forces who have a service-con-

1 nected disability to receive both military retired pay by
2 reason of their years of military service and disability com-
3 pensation from the Department of Veterans Affairs for
4 their disability. The bill shall be considered as read for
5 amendment. The previous question shall be considered as
6 ordered on the bill and on any amendment thereto to final
7 passage without intervening motion except: (1) four hours
8 of debate on the bill equally divided among and controlled
9 by the chairmen and ranking minority members of the
10 Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on Vet-
11 erans' Affairs; (2) an amendment in the nature of a sub-
12 stitute printed in the Congressional Record pursuant to
13 clause 8 of rule XVIII, if offered by Representative
14 Hunter of California or his designee, which shall be con-
15 sidered as read and shall be separately debatable for one
16 hour equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
17 an opponent; and (3) one motion to recommit with or
18 without instructions.

19 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 303 pursuant
20 to the first section of this resolution, notwithstanding the
21 operation of the previous question, the Chair may post-
22 pone further consideration of the bill to a time designated
23 by the Speaker on the same legislative day or until the
24 following legislative day when consideration shall resume
