Mr. LINCOLN DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2115) to amend title 49, United States Code, to reauthorize programs for the Federal Aviation Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2115) to amend title 49, United

1 States Code, to reauthorize programs for the Federal
2 Aviation Administration, and for other purposes. The first
3 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
4 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
5 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
6 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
7 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Trans-
8 portation and Infrastructure. After general debate the bill
9 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute
10 rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill
11 for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule
12 the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended
13 by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure
14 now printed in the bill, modified by the amendment print-
15 ed in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules ac-
16 companying this resolution. That amendment in the na-
17 ture of a substitute shall be considered as read. All points
18 of order against that amendment in the nature of a sub-
19 stitute are waived. No amendment to that amendment in
20 the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those
21 printed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules.
22 Each such amendment may be offered only in the order
23 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member
24 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
25 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally

1 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
2 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-
3 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House
4 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order
5 against such amendment are waived. At the conclusion of
6 consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
7 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
8 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may
9 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
10 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
11 the amendment in the nature of a substitute made in order
12 as original text. The previous question shall be considered
13 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final
14 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
15 recommit with or without instructions.
