Mr. LINCOLN DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4567) making appropriations for the Department of Homeland Security for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4567) making appropriations for

1 the Department of Homeland Security for the fiscal year  
2 ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes. The  
3 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points  
4 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-  
5 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-  
6 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-  
7 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
8 Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be con-  
9 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points  
10 of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply  
11 with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except as follows:  
12 the proviso under the heading “United States Visitor and  
13 Immigrant Status Indicator Technology”; the proviso  
14 under the heading “Customs and Border Protection, Auto-  
15 mation Modernization”; the proviso under the heading  
16 “Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Automation  
17 Modernization”; the final proviso under the heading  
18 “Transportation Security Administration, Aviation Secu-  
19 rity”; the words “notwithstanding any other provision of  
20 law” under the heading “State and Local Programs”; the  
21 second proviso under the heading “National Pre-Disaster  
22 Mitigation Fund”; section 512; the final proviso in section  
23 513; sections 514, 515, 519, and 520; all after the word  
24 “met” in section 524; section 525, and subsection 526(b).  
25 Where points of order are waived against part of a para-

1 graph or section, points of order against a provision in  
2 another part of such paragraph or section may be made  
3 only against such provision and not against the entire  
4 paragraph or section. During consideration of the bill for  
5 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole  
6 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether  
7 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be  
8 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-  
9 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amend-  
10 ments so printed shall be considered as read. At the con-  
11 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the  
12 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with  
13 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous  
14 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
15 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
16 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
17 structions.
