Mr. LINCOLN DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4818) making appropriations for foreign operations, export financing, and related programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4818) making appropriations for

1 foreign operations, export financing, and related programs
2 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, and for
3 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
4 pensed with. All points of order against consideration of
5 the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to
6 the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and
7 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
8 of the Committee on Appropriations. After general debate
9 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
10 minute rule. Points of order against provisions in the bill
11 for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived
12 except: beginning with the semicolon in section 565(a)(2)
13 through “501)” in section 565(a)(3). Where points of
14 order are waived against part of a section, points of order
15 against a provision in another part of such section may
16 be made only against such provision and not against the
17 entire section. During consideration of the bill for amend-
18 ment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may
19 accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the
20 Member offering an amendment has caused it to be print-
21 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated
22 for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments
23 so printed shall be considered as read. At the conclusion
24 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
25 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such

1 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
2 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
3 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
4 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
5 structions.
