- 3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

- 5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4837) making appropriations for

- 2 ment and closure for the Department of Defense for the

- 4 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
- 5 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
- 6 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
- 7 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
- 8 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
- 9 Committee on Appropriations. After general debate the
- 10 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
- 11 minute rule. Points of order against provisions in the bill
- 12 for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived
- 13 except: section 129. During consideration of the bill for
- 14 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole
- 15 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether
- 16 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be
- 17 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-
- 18 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amend-
- 19 ments so printed shall be considered as read. At the con-
- 20 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
- 21 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
- 22 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
- 23 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
- 24 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening

- 1 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
- 2 structions.
