Ms. PRYCE of Ohio, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5006) making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

1 ation of the bill (H.R. 5006) making appropriations for  
2 the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services,  
3 and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year  
4 ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes. The  
5 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points  
6 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-  
7 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-  
8 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-  
9 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
10 Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be con-  
11 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points  
12 of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply  
13 with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except: sections  
14 219(b), 221, and 506. Where points of order are waived  
15 against part of a section, points of order against a provi-  
16 sion in another part of such section may be made only  
17 against such provision and not against the entire section.  
18 During consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chair-  
19 man of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority  
20 in recognition on the basis of whether the Member offering  
21 an amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion  
22 of the Congressional Record designated for that purpose  
23 in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall  
24 be considered as read. At the conclusion of consideration  
25 of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and

1 report the bill to the House with such amendments as may  
2 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-  
3 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to  
4 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-  
5 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
