RESOLUTION

Of inquiry requesting the President and directing the Secretary of Health and Human Services provide certain documents to the House of Representatives relating to

estimates and analyses of the cost of the Medicare prescription drug legislation.

1 *Resolved*, That (a) the President is requested and the
2 Secretary of Health and Human Services is directed, to
3 the extent possible, to furnish the House of Representa-
4 tives, not later than 14 days after the adoption of this
5 resolution, all documents, including telephone and elec-
6 tronic mail records, logs and calendars, and records of in-
7 ternal discussions in the possession of the Secretary of
8 Health and Human Resources, the Director of the Office
9 of Management and Budget, and the Director of the Office
10 of the National Economic Council, respectively, relating
11 to the following:

12 (1) Any estimates and any analyses made by
13 the Department of Health and Human Services or
14 the Office of Management and Budget relating to
15 the cost of any version of the medicare prescription
16 drug legislation.

17 (2) Any communications (whether written or
18 electronic) relating to such cost estimates or anal-
19 yses or their release to Members of Congress be-
20 tween employees within the executive branch.

21 (3) Any communications (whether written or
22 electronic) relating to such cost estimates or anal-
23 yses or their release to Members of Congress be-

1 tween employees of the executive branch and Mem-
2 bers of Congress or their staff.

3 (4) Any communications (whether written or
4 electronic) relating to such cost estimates or anal-
5 yses or their release to Members of Congress be-
6 tween employees of the executive branch and persons
7 other than employees of the executive branch or leg-
8 islative branch.

9 (b) As used in this resolution, the term “any version
10 of the medicare prescription drug legislation” refers to any
11 version of H.R. 1 or S. 1 (108th Congress), including the
12 conference report on H.R. 1.

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
