Mr. OBEY submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4421) making appropriations for the Environmental Protection Agency for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4421) making appropriations for  
6 the Environmental Protection Agency for the fiscal year  
7 ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes. The  
8 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points

1 of order against the bill and against its consideration are  
2 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and  
3 shall not exceed 90 minutes with one hour equally divided  
4 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority  
5 member of the Committee on Appropriations and 30 min-  
6 utes equally divided and controlled by the chairman and  
7 ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways and  
8 Means. After general debate the bill shall be considered  
9 for amendment under the five-minute rule. During consid-  
10 eration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the  
11 Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recogni-  
12 tion on the basis of whether the Member offering an  
13 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of  
14 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in  
15 clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be  
16 considered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of  
17 the bill for amendment, the Committee shall rise and re-  
18 port the bill to the House with such amendments as may  
19 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-  
20 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to  
21 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-  
22 tion to recommit with or without instructions.

23       SEC. 2. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-  
24 ports that it has come to no resolution on the bill, then  
25 on the next legislative day the House shall, immediately

1 after the third daily order of business under clause 1 of  
2 rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the Whole for fur-  
3 ther consideration of the bill.
