## RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives respecting the availability of legislation on the Internet.

1       *Resolved*, That clause 6(c) of rule XIII of the Rules  
2 of the House of Representatives is amended by striking  
3 the period at the end of subparagraph (2) and inserting  
4 a semicolon and by adding at the end the following new  
5 subparagraph:

6               “(3) a rule or order eliminating the reading in  
7 full of any bill, resolution, conference report, or  
8 amendment unless such measure is available to all  
9 Members and made available to the general public

1       by means of the Internet for at least 24 hours before  
2       its consideration.”.

3       SEC. 2. The amendment made by the first section of  
4 this resolution shall take effect immediately before noon  
5 January 3, 2005.
