Resolved, That clause 6(c) of rule XIII of the Rules
 of the House of Representatives is amended by striking
 the period at the end of subparagraph (2) and inserting
 a semicolon and by adding at the end the following new
 subparagraph:

6 "(3) a rule or order eliminating the reading in
7 full of any bill, resolution, conference report, or
8 amendment unless such measure is available to all
9 Members and made available to the general public

by means of the Internet for at least 24 hours before
 its consideration.".

3 SEC. 2. The amendment made by the first section of
4 this resolution shall take effect immediately before noon
5 January 3, 2005.
