A BILL

To increase the annual salaries of justices and judges of the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. JUDICIAL SALARY INCREASE.
- 4 The annual salaries of the Chief Justice of the United
- 5 States, associate justices of the Supreme Court of the
- 6 United States, United States circuit judges, United States
- 7 district judges, judges of the United States Court of Inter-
- 8 national Trade, and judges of the United States Court of
- 9 Federal Claims are increased in the amount of 16.5 per-
- 10 cent of their respective existing annual salary rates,

- 1 rounded to the nearest \$100 (or, if midway between mul-
- 2 tiples of \$100, to the next higher multiple of \$100).

3 SEC. 2. COORDINATION RULE.

- 4 If a pay adjustment under section 1 is to be made
- 5 for an office or position as of the same date that any other
- 6 pay adjustment would take effect for such office or posi-
- 7 tion, the adjustment under this Act shall be made first.

8 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 9 This Act shall take effect on the first day of the first
- 10 applicable pay period beginning on or after January 1,
- 11 2004.
