A BILL

To extend the Temporary Extended Unemployment Compensation Act of 2002.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Unemployment Com-
5 pensation Amendments of 2003”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY EXTENDED UNEM-
7 PLOYMENT COMPENSATION ACT OF 2002.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 208 of the Temporary Ex-
9 tended Unemployment Compensation Act of 2002 (Public

2 108–1 (117 Stat. 3), is amended—

3 (1) in subsection (a)(2), by striking “before

4 June 1” and inserting “on or before November 30”;

5 (2) in subsection (b)(1), by striking “May 31,

6 2003” and inserting “November 30, 2003”;

7 (3) in subsection (b)(2)—

8 (A) in the heading, by striking “MAY 31,

9 2003” and inserting “NOVEMBER 30, 2003”; and

10 (B) by striking “May 31, 2003” and in-

11 serting “November 30, 2003”; and

12 (4) in subsection (b)(3), by striking “August

13 30, 2003” and inserting “February 28, 2004”.

14 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by

15 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-

16 ment of the Temporary Extended Unemployment Com-

17 pensation Act of 2002 (Public Law 107–147; 116 Stat.

18 21).
