AN ACT

- To establish within the National Park Service the 225th Anniversary of the American Revolution Commemorative Program, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "225th Anniversary of
- 5 the American Revolution Commemoration Act".

1 SEC. 2. FINDINGS AND PURPOSES.

2 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—

3 (1) the American Revolution, inspired by the
4 spirit of liberty and independence among the inhab5 itants of the original 13 English colonies, was an
6 event of global significance having a profound and
7 lasting effect on the government, laws, culture, soci8 ety, and values of the United States;

9 (2) the years 2000 through 2008 mark the
10 225th anniversary of the American Revolution;

(3) citizens of the United States should have an
opportunity to understand and appreciate the continuing legacy of the American Revolution;

(4) the 225th anniversary of the American Revolution provides an opportunity to enhance public
awareness and understanding of the impact of the
American Revolution on the lives of citizens of the
United States;

19 (5) although the National Park Service admin-20 isters battlefields, historical parks, historic sites, and 21 programs that address elements of the story of the 22 American Revolution, there is a need to establish 23 partnerships that link those sites and programs with 24 sites and programs of other Federal and non-Federal entities to place the story of the American Revo-25 26 lution in the broad context of the causes, consequences, and significance of the American Revolu tion; and

3 (6) a national program of the National Park
4 Service that links historic structures and sites,
5 routes, activities, community projects, exhibits, and
6 multimedia materials in a manner that is unified
7 and flexible is the best method of conveying to citi8 zens of the United States the story and significance
9 of the American Revolution.

10 (b) PURPOSES.—The purposes of this Act are—

(1) to recognize the enduring importance of the
American Revolution to the lives of citizens of the
United States; and

(2) to authorize the National Park Service to
coordinate, connect, and facilitate Federal and nonFederal activities to commemorate, honor, and interpret the history of the American Revolution, including the significance and relevance of the American
Revolution to the shape and spirit of the Government and society of the United States.

21 SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.

(2) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means 3 4 the Secretary of the Interior. 5 SEC. 4. 225TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE AMERICAN REVOLU-6 TION COMMEMORATION PROGRAM. 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall establish 8 within the National Park Service a program to be known as the "225th Anniversary of the American Revolution 9 10 Commemoration Program". 11 (b) ACTIVITIES.—In carrying out the program, the 12 Secretary shall— 13 (1) produce and distribute to the public edu-14 cational materials relating to the American Revolu-15 tion, such as— 16 (A) handbooks; 17 (B) maps; 18 (C) interpretive guides; and 19 (D) electronic information; 20 (2) enter into appropriate cooperative agree-21 ments and memoranda of understanding to provide 22 technical assistance under subsection (d);

23 (3) assist in the protection of resources associ24 ated with the American Revolution;

4 (d) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS AND MEMORANDA 5 OF UNDERSTANDING.—To achieve the purposes of this 6 Act and to ensure the effective coordination of the Federal 7 and non-Federal components of the Program with Na-8 tional Park Service units and programs, the Secretary 9 may enter into cooperative agreements and memoranda of 10 understanding with, and provide technical assistance to—

(1) the heads of other Federal agencies, States,
units of local government, and private entities; and
(2) in cooperation with the Secretary of State,
the Governments of the United Kingdom, France,
the Netherlands, Spain, and Canada.

(e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to carry
out this Act \$500,000 for each of fiscal years 2004
through 2009.
