A BILL

To extend the national flood insurance program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Flood Insur-
5 ance Program Reauthorization Act of 2003”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PRO-**
7 **GRAM.**

8 (a) EXTENSION.—The National Flood Insurance Act
9 of 1968 is amended—

1 (1) in section 1309(a)(2) (42 U.S.C.
2 4016(a)(2)), by striking “December 31, 2002” and
3 inserting “December 31, 2003”;

4 (2) in section 1319 (42 U.S.C. 4026), by strik-
5 ing “after” and all that follows through the period
6 at the end and inserting “after December 31,
7 2003.”;

8 (3) in section 1336(a) (42 U.S.C. 4056(a)), by
9 striking “ending” and all that follows through “in”
10 and inserting “ending December 31, 2003, in”; and

11 (4) in section 1376(c) (42 U.S.C. 4127), by
12 striking “December 31, 2002” and inserting “De-
13 cember 31, 2003”.

14 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
15 this section shall be considered to have taken effect on
16 December 31, 2002.
