1 SEC. 2. ILLEGAL FIREARMS TRAFFICKING. 2 IMPRISON-(a) INCREASED MAXIMUM TERM \mathbf{OF} 3 MENT.—Section 924 of title 18, United States Code, is 4 amended-5 (1) in subsection (a)(2)— (A) by inserting "(A)" after "(2)"; 6 (B) by striking "(d),"; and 7 8 (C) by adding at the end the following: 9 "(B) Whoever knowingly violates sub-10 section (d) of section 922 shall be fined under 11 this title, imprisoned not more than 20 years, 12 or both."; 13 (2) in subsection (g), by striking "10 years, fined in accordance with" and inserting "20 years, 14 15 fined under"; 16 (3) in subsection (h), by striking "10 years, fined in accordance with" and inserting "20 years, 17 18 fined under"; and 19 (4) in subsection (n), by striking "10 years" 20 and inserting "20 years". 21 SENTENCING GUIDELINES.—Notwithstanding (b) 22 any other provision of law regarding the amendment of 23 the Sentencing Guidelines, the United States Sentencing 24 Commission shall amend the Sentencing Guidelines to— 25 (1) raise the base offense level for interstate 26 firearms trafficking under section 922(d) of title 18,

United States Code, and subsections (g), (h), and
(n) of section 924 of such title, as set out under sec tion 2K2.1 of the Sentencing Guidelines, to not less
than level 20; and

5 (2) increase the punishment for violations of 6 section 922(d) of title 18, United States Code, and 7 subsections (g), (h), and (n) of section 924 of such 8 title, in conformance with the amendments made 9 under paragraph (1).

10 (c) RACKETEERING ACTIVITY.—Section 1961(1) of 11 title 18, United States Code, is amended by inserting "sec-12 tion 922(d) (relating to firearms sales to ineligible per-13 sons), subsections (g), (h), and (n) of section 924 (relating 14 to illegal firearms trafficking)," before "section 1028".
