## A BILL

To decrease the matching funds requirement and authorize additional appropriations for Keweenaw National Historical Park in the State of Michigan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FUNDING FOR KEWEENAW NATIONAL HISTOR-**  
4 **ICAL PARK.**

5 (a) MATCHING FUNDS.—Section 8(b) of Public Law  
6 102–543 (16 U.S.C. 410yy–7(b)) is amended by striking  
7 “\$4” and inserting “\$1”.

1 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section  
2 10(a) of Public Law 102–543 (16 U.S.C. 410yy–9(a)) is  
3 amended—

4 (1) by striking “\$25,000,000” and inserting  
5 “\$50,000,000”; and

6 (2) by striking “\$3,000,000” and inserting  
7 “\$25,000,000”.
