A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide for appropriate overtime pay for National Weather Service employees who perform essential services during severe weather events.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. OVERTIME RATES.
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5542(a) of title 5, United
- 5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 6 lowing:
- 7 "(6)(A) Notwithstanding paragraphs (1) and
- 8 (2), the overtime pay shall be as provided in sub-

1	paragraph (B) for an employee of the National
2	Weather Service—
3	"(i) who occupies a nonmanagerial position
4	in GS-14 or under; and
5	"(ii) as determined by the Secretary of
6	Commerce, whose position involves—
7	"(I) duties that are critical to the im-
8	mediate daily operation of the forecast and
9	warning responsibilities of the National
10	Weather Service and directly affect public
11	and aviation safety; and
12	"(II) overtime work that is usually
13	unscheduled due to the vicissitudes of se-
14	vere weather and is therefore unusually
15	taxing.
16	"(B) The overtime hourly rate of pay is an
17	amount equal to one and one-half times the hourly
18	rate of basic pay of the employee, and all that
19	amount is premium pay.".
20	(b) Exemption From Limitation.—Section
21	5547(d) of title 5, United States Code, is amended by
22	striking the period and inserting ", or to any employee
23	of the National Weather Service who occupies a position
24	described in section 5542(a)(6).".
