A BILL

To redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 101 South Vine Street in Glenwood, Iowa, as the “William J. Scherle Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WILLIAM J. SCHERLE POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The facility of the United
5 States Postal Service located at 101 South Vine Street
6 in Glenwood, Iowa, and known as the Glenwood Main Of-
7 fice, shall be known and designated as the “William J.
8 Scherle Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the William J. Scherle Post
5 Office Building.
