## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 514 17th Street in Moline, Illinois, as the “David Bybee Post Office Building”.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DAVID BYBEE POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 514 17th Street in Moline, Illi-  
6 nois, shall be known and designated as the “David Bybee  
7 Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
2 be deemed to be a reference to the David Bybee Post Of-  
3 fice Building.
