## 1 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF PROGRAM AUTHORITY.

- 2 (a) In General.—Any program, authority, or provi-
- 3 sion, including any pilot program, authorized under the
- 4 Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 631 et seq.) or the Small
- 5 Business Investment Act of 1958 (15 U.S.C. 661 et seq.)
- 6 as of September 30, 2003, that is scheduled to expire on
- 7 or after September 30, 2003 and before March 15, 2004,
- 8 shall remain authorized through March 15, 2004, under
- 9 the same terms and conditions in effect on September 30,
- 10 2003.
- 11 (b) Exception.—Notwithstanding subsection (a),
- 12 section 303(g)(2) of the Small Business Investment Act
- 13 of 1958 (15 U.S.C. 683(g)(2)) is amended by striking
- 14 "1.38 percent" and inserting "1.46 percent".
