A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF APPLICABILITY OF SUNSET OF THE**
2 **ECONOMIC GROWTH AND TAX RELIEF REC-**
3 **ONCILIATION ACT OF 2001 WITH RESPECT TO**
4 **ADOPTION CREDIT AND ADOPTION ASSIST-**
5 **ANCE PROGRAMS.**

6 Section 901 of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief
7 Reconciliation Act of 2001 is amended by adding at the
8 end the following new subsection:

9 “(c) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a) shall not apply to
10 the amendments made by section 202 (relating to expan-
11 sion of adoption credit and adoption assistance pro-
12 grams).”.
