# **AN ACT**

For the relief of Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical.  $\,$ 

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### 1 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.

- 2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 3 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 4 1101 et seq.), Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical shall be held
- 5 and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the
- 6 United States for permanent residence as of the date of
- 7 enactment of this Act upon payment of the required visa
- 8 fees.

## 9 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

- 10 Upon the granting of permanent residence to
- 11 Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical, the Secretary of State
- 12 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the
- 13 current fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas
- 14 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth
- 15 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 16 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
